About This Calendar

This calendar follows the 364-day solar calendar witnessed in the Dead Sea Scrolls and described in 1 Enoch — a fixed schematic year of twelve months in a 30-30-31 quarterly pattern, totaling exactly fifty-two weeks. Because 364 divides cleanly by 7, every date falls on the same weekday in every year. Passover (M1 D14) is always a Tuesday. Pentecost (M3 D15) is always a Sunday. The Day of Atonement (M7 D10) is always a Friday.

The year begins on the first Wednesday on or after the Jerusalem vernal equinox — the Fourth-Gate rule of 1 Enoch 72. For 2026, that anchor is Wednesday, March 25.

Each entry on this calendar shows the original DSS month and day (e.g., M1 D14), the weekday it falls on, and the corresponding 2026 Gregorian date. Scripture references and a brief devotional caption accompany each event. Read alongside your Bible, this calendar offers a way to recognize the covenant rhythms God has woven through Israel's history, the life of Christ, and the witness of the prophets and apostles.

Many of these events repeat — different generations and different witnesses meeting at the same date on the calendar. Watch for the convergences. They are not coincidences.

How to Read Each Entry

M1 D14 (Tue) — The DSS calendar coordinate (Month 1, Day 14) and its fixed weekday

Apr 7, 2026 — The 2026 Gregorian projection

Passover — The biblical event

Exodus 12:6, 13 — The scripture anchor

Patterns of Redemption

Across this year you have seen events from Israel's exodus, the conquest of Canaan, the kingdom of David and Solomon, the prophets of exile and return, and the fulfillment of feast in Christ and his apostles — all meeting on the same fixed coordinates of the DSS calendar. These convergences are not coincidence. The 364-day calendar, anchored to the creation week and the Fourth-Gate luminary witness of 1 Enoch, holds covenant time still while the generations move through it.

Three convergences in particular reward attention:

M1 D14 (Tuesday) — The Triple Passover Anchor

The blood of the Egyptian Passover, the first Passover kept in the land of Canaan, and the Passover Christ fulfilled — all meeting on a single DSS coordinate.

M1 D15 (Wednesday) — The Threshold Mirror

Israel departs Egypt with no produce of the field, and forty years later the next generation eats the produce of the promised land — both on M1 D15.

M1 D1 (Wednesday) — The Presence Mirror

The tabernacle is raised in Year 2 of the wilderness, and Year 41 begins as the conquest threshold — both on the New Year that always falls on the day God ordered the lights for signs and seasons.

These are the rhythms God has spoken through time. May this year's calendar serve as one small witness to the coherence of his work, from creation to inheritance to fulfillment in Christ.
